

## How to cut the outline of a Picture using Photoshop:

1. Open the picture
2. Click **filter** @menu bar and select **extract**
3. Select **smarthighlighting** on the tool bar on right side
4. Use the mouse to cut the outline of the picture. Put the center of the circle at the cutting line and move the mouse slowly. To increase the tool circle press the “[”key and to decrease press “]”
5. Make sure the cutting line is unbroken. When finished click the **fill** tool (paint box)
6. Click **preview** on the right side menu.
7. Click **cleanup** tool on the left side tool bar. Move the tool around the cutting line to clean the unwanted areas. To regain the lost parts, press **Alt** key and move the tool. To pull the picture up or down so that you can do the cleanup easily, press **spacebar** to reveal the hand tool.
8. Click OK when finished.
9. Click the **move** tool on top right tool bar and try to move the cut area by moving the mouse.
10. Open background picture.
11. Drag cut picture to background picture
12. Change size of cut picture to fit background
13. Click **layer** on menu bar and select **flatten**.
14. Click **cloning tool** (stamp tool) to fix the picture.  
Click alt to pick sample color when fixing bad areas.
